Special Conditions for Malaysia My Second Home (MM2H) Participants Under Special Economic/Financial Zones

The Ministry of Tourism, Arts, and Culture has introduced special conditions for the MM2H Program under the country's new Special Financial Zones. The special conditions for the MM2H Program under the Special **Economic/Financial Zones** are as follows:

AGE REQUIREMENT FOR	Applicants aged 21 and above, especially to encourage foreign investment.
PARTICIPATION	
FINANCIAL	i. Applicants must have a fixed deposit (FD) of:
REQUIREMENTS	- USD 65,000 for ages 21 to 49; and
	- USD 32,000 for ages 50 and above.
	ii. The FD must be placed in any financial

	iii. A maximum withdrawal of 50% from the

PARTICIPATION FEE (ONE-OFF)	i. A participation fee of RM1,000 for the principal applicant (one-off).

	ii. NO participation fee for dependents.
PURCHASE OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY	 i. Applicants are required to purchase and own a property/house (with a minimum price subject to the relevant state property acquisition policy) after receiving approval to join the MM2H Program. ii. It is required that the house purchase be made directly from the property developer, not through real estate agents or existing owners. iii. The purchased property/house cannot be resold within 10 years. However, upgrading the house (buying a new one) to a higher value than the current house is allowed. iv. If participants do not comply with these conditions, their MM2H pass may be revoked.
MINIMUM OF STAYS	 i. Residing in Malaysia for at least 90 days (cumulatively) within a year. ii. For participants aged 21 to 49, the stay in Malaysia must be fulfilled either by the principal applicant or their dependents.
DEPENDENTS	Participants are allowed to bring their dependents, which consist of: i. spouse (wife/husband);

	ii. biological children/stepchildren/adopted children under 21 years old, while those aged between 21 and 34 must be unemployed or unmarried in Malaysia; iii.disabled children (no age limit) as certified by a medical expert; and
MM2H VISA	 iv. parents and/or parents-in-law. i. MM2H pass for a duration of 10 years with Multiple Entry Visa (MEV) for the principal applicant and dependents. ii. It can be renewed. iii. The validity period of the security sticker is
	based on the approved duration of the MM2H pass, subject to the validity period of the participant's passport. iv. If the validity period of the participant's passport expires before the MM2H pass, the participant must renew the security sticker.
EDUCATION	Dependents (children) are allowed to pursue education in Malaysia up to the higher education level at institutions of higher learning (IPT) recognized by the Government of Malaysia. Dependents (children) are permitted to use the existing MM2H pass or will be automatically granted a Student Pass.
MEDICAL TREATMENT	Allowed to undergo long-term medical treatment in Malaysia.

BUSINESS ACTIVITIES/ INVESTMENT	i. Not allowed. ii. Must apply for the relevant pass.
EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES	i. Not allowed. ii. Must apply for the relevant pass.
HEALTH SCREENING	It is mandatory to undergo a health screening at clinics/hospitals (panel clinics) appointed by the Ministry of Tourism, Arts, and Culture for the principal applicant and dependents after receiving approval to join the MM2H Program. These panel clinics ensure that the services and fees charged to all applicants of the MM2H Program are standardized.
ADVANTAGES OF THE PROGRAM	Tax exemption on offshore income and funds brought in, such as fixed deposits (FD).
APPLICATION TO CHANGE PRINCIPAL	In the event of the principal's death, the MM2H pass of the deceased is allowed to be transferred to the nearest heir (next-of-kin) who is a named dependent of the principal.
TERMS FOR RENEWAL OF PASS	 The pass can be renewed every 5 years after the maximum membership period of the program ends. Applicants must resubmit the latest documents as follows: i. A copy of a valid passport ii. A copy of the medical report iii. Health insurance

 The renewal pass fee is RM300 for the principal applicant and dependents.
